This is a nice surprise. With inexpensive pinot, at best I expect a somewhat thin but fruit-driven wine. This one not only has body, but a lot of delicious fresh red fruits. There's a touch of oak, which adds some spice for extra interest. This is "proper" pinot, with a perfect balance between freshness and texture. Grape variety: pinot noir. Residual sugar: 1.6 g/L. Serve at: 16 C. Drink now. Food pairing ideas: apéritif, seafood pasta with cream sauce and herbs.
